Permit Application Submittal Requirement Guideline

Addition at Home Owner Center

2019-004

This checklist provides guidance to documents submittal requirements for applications that pertain to one story Additions up to 500sq.ft in area and 8ft in height at ground level, no removal of exterior load bearing wall, in a Single and Two Family Dwelling Units.

Discipline reviews required: Structural Review, Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing, Zoning, DDOT, and DOEE.

References: International Building Code 2012 edition as amended by DCMR12A and B

- [DCBC 106.1.13 Official Building Plat]—Plat required for erection of retaining walls higher than 48inches.
- [DCBC 106.2 Site plan] site plan is required to erect retaining walls.
- [DCBC 105.3.10] Design Professional Required.
- [DCRC] all applicable sections of DC Residential Code -2012
- DCRA permitting Fee schedule (available online).
