

2023 Steps to Obtaining a Fireworks Permit with DOB

Step 1 - NEW or MODIFIED FIREWORK STANDS. Apply online for a Fireworks Stand permit through the <u>Citizen Access Portal</u>. All site plans will be reviewed in ProjectDox under our Digital Walk-Through process.

- a. A site plan is required to show the temporary structure dimensions. Complete with stand framing size and connection details along with anchoring to the ground.
- b. A Surveyor Plat is required to show whether the stand will be located on the property.

Returning Firework Applicants – Applicants who were previously licensed in 2022

If you are a returning applicant, at the same location, a building permit is **NOT REQUIRED**. Applicants can proceed with applying for a Certificate of Occupancy using the Citizen Access Portal.

 All prior APPROVED documents must be uploaded with your submission for acceptance. (This includes prior approved drawings and issued Certificate of Occupancy)

Step 2 – Certificate of Occupancy. New or Modified Firework Stand applicants are required to apply for a Certificate of Occupancy online using the Citizen Access Portal.

- a. Upload the issued Fireworks Stand Permit
- b. If you are not the property owner, please provide authorization from the property owner with your submission.

An inspection will be required prior to final approval of your Certificate of Occupancy.
