


HOW COMPLIANCE IS ENFORCED

A property owner is responsible for addressing code violations at their own expense. When a property owner fails to comply within a reasonable period, DOB enforces compliance with processes and tools available under the law. While DC laws, rules, codes, and regulations provide a framework for DOB code enforcement, achieving compliance is a complex process requiring strategy, engagement with stakeholders, and time anywhere from 30 days to 18+months, depending on whether the case is contested, intricate, or involves other agencies. To empower the general public and promote transparency, below is an overview of how enforcement works and online tools to track the path an enforcement action may take to a resolution.





Life-safety or emergency infractions follow a different accelerated process.

These agencies include, but are not limited to...











- 1. Use **DISPATCH** to request and track inspections on-demand.
- 2. Use **SCOUT** to review permits, inspections, licensing, and enforcement data.
- 3. Use **eRECORDS** to view building plans and documents.
- 4. Use the **DOB AGENCY DASHBOARD** to track fines, adjudication status, vacant properties, and more.
